Class 200: The All-Ireland Home Preserves Championship - FINAL

The Irish Shows Association and Arva Show present the All Ireland Home Preserve Championship Sponsored by: Breffni Landscapes PRIZE FUND €600

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

(1) Display 3 pots of preserves from each section below. Pots used to be no bigger than 454g or1lb - all the same size

- Soft Fruits
- Stoned Fruits
- Marmalade

Max. space allowed 22cm x 22cm

(2) Points will be awarded for taste, appearance, sealing, setting and presentation.

- (3) Lids only to be used
- (4) No biscuits or scones to be displayed with exhibit
- (5) Simple presentation only required
- (6) Two exhibits will qualify from each show.
- (7) The exhibits must be home produced by the exhibitor.
- (8) This competition is confined to amateurs
- (9) In the event of an objection and following an investigation, and if the exhibitor is deemed to be making a living from their profession, they may be disqualified.
- (10) A special class will be held at each qualifying show
- (11) All preserves will be sampled.
- (12) The judge's decision at all stages of the competition is final
- (13) Exhibits are displayed at owner's risk
- (14) For the final, fresh pots of preserves must be entered
- (15) An exhibitor can only qualify one exhibit for the All-Ireland Final

Class 202: The Bord Bia 7-a-Day Best in Season Kitchen/Garden All Ireland.

The ISA & Tullamore Show Present The Bord Bia 7 a Day Best in Season Kitchen/Garden All Ireland. SPONSORED BY BORD BIA

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

- 1. This competition is to encourage growers to exhibit produce from their own kitchen garden.
- 2. In this competition, the produce should be the property of and be grown by the exhibitor.
- 3. Each exhibit must consist of a display of fruit and vegetables excluding potatoes.
- 4. Not fewer than 7 kinds.
- 5. Not more than 10. Foliage and root growth may be trimmed for display purposes and herbs may be included.
- The veg and fruit should be displayed within an area not larger than 610mm x 610mm (24"x24") and not exceeding 90cm (3ft).
- 7. However, foliage and roots may extend beyond that boundary but not rest on the show bench.
- 8. At the final, Marquee open from 7.30am on show morning and will be closed for judging at 10 am sharp. Marquee will open to the public at 12 noon.
- 9. Exhibits cannot be removed before 5.00 pm.
- 10. An exhibitor can only qualify **one exhibit** for the All Ireland final

THE COMPETITION WILL BE JUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

Variety: 25 points, Condition and quality: 50 points, Overall presentation and attractiveness: 25 points.

Class 203: The Bord Bia All-Ireland Quality Potato Championship.

The ISA & Tullamore Show Society present The Quality Potato All Ireland Championship. RULES & CONDITIONS:

- 1. In this competition, the produce must be the property of and grown by the exhibitor.
- Each exhibit is to consist of the following: A dish of 6 potatoes of any variety. The variety to be correctly named. Each tuber should be free from skin blemishes, be true to type and weigh approximately 6oz (170g)
- 3. Two exhibits may qualify at each show.
- 4. This being a quality championship, the adjudicators will favour floury, high dry matter varieties, which are popular with the Irish customer.
- 5. These rules should be read in conjunction with the rules of the Irish Shows Association.Rules.
- 6. At the final, Marquee open from 7.30am on show morning and will be closed for judging at 10 am sharp. Marquee will open to the public at 12 noon.
- 7. Exhibits cannot be removed before 5.00 pm.
- 8. An exhibitor can only qualify **one exhibit** for the All Ireland final

Class 204: The Quality Onion All Ireland Championship.

The ISA & Virginia Show Society present The Quality Onion All Ireland Championship. RULES & CONDITIONS:

- 1. In this competition, the produce must be the property of and grown by the exhibitor.
- 2. Each exhibit is to consist of the following: A dish of 5 onions of any variety.
- 3. The onions may be grown from either seed or sets.
- 4. The onions may be Autumn or Spring sown. The variety to be correctly named.
- 5. Each onion must be tied and weigh not more than 450grams.
- 6. The onions to be harvested and have clear unbroken skins.
- 7. A special qualifying class will be held at selected shows. Two exhibits may qualify for the Final, if the Judges agree thatthe standard is high enough.
- 8. Judges decision will be final at all stages of the competition. Exhibits are displayed at owner's risk.
- 9. These rules should be read in conjunction with the rules of the I. S. A Rules.
- 10. The Competition will be judged as follows:
 - Condition/Quality: 25 points, Uniformity and Shape: 25 points Size/Weight: 10 points, Colour: 10 points Overall presentation/attractiveness: 10 points.

Class 205: The Fleetwood Paints All Ireland Amateur Painting Competition.

The ISA & Virginia Show present The Fleetwood Paints All Ireland Amateur Painting Competition. RULES & CONDITIONS

- 1. Paintings must be the sole work of the exhibitor who must have amateur status.
- 2. Paintings to depict an Agricultural or Rural setting.
- 3. Paintings must measure no more than 24"X 20" including the frame.
- 4. All Paintings must be ready to hang, that is framed and with a hanging cord attached.
- 5. The Judges decision will be final.
- 6. All entries to be exhibited at owners risk.
- 7. All entries to have amateur status as defined by the following: (a) Not to have had a commercial solo exhibition (b) Not to have exhibited in a commercial gallery (c) Not to be teaching or have taught art in any form.
- 8. In the event of an objection and following an investigation, and if the exhibitor is deemed to be making their living from their profession, they may be disqualified
- 9. Maximum of two exhibits only from any one exhibitor can qualify
- 10. Qualifying exhibit(s) to be photographed by relevant qualifying show.
- 11. Secretaries to forward same to the National Secretary in advance of the Final
- 12. The same painting that qualifies at the qualifying show must be exhibited at the final
- 13. An exhibitor can only qualify one exhibit for the All Ireland Final
- 14. These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A Rules

- 2. Each exhibit must consist of 1 article from point A plus 1 other article from points B, C or D. Making a **total of 2 articles**

A) Any article using tweed eg Picture (min size 12"x12" - max size 18"x18" excluding the frame and mount), Cushion (min size 16"x16" - max size 18"x18") or skirt (adult size only)

- B) Any article in coloured or self-embroidery made in the current year
- C) Hand knit cardigan lumber jacket or jumper (adult size only)
- D) Any article in cotton crochet using no thicker than a no.20 cotton thread
- 3. All of the above to be made in the current year
- 4. The items to be displayed as one exhibit
- 5. Any item the judge believes is produced by any other method other than than shall be disqualified
- 6. A special class will be held at each qualifying show
- 7. One entry may qualify from from each qualifying show for the final, if judges agree than the standard is high enough a second entry may be qualified.
- 8. Each of the successful qualifiers will receive a rosette on appearance at the final
