**Class 2: Lead Rein Competition for Ponies 12.2 hands & under, lead by an adult & ridden by a child 7 years & under**

**Class 3: Lead Rein Competition for Ponies 14.2 hands & under, lead by an adult & ridden by child 8-12 years old**

**Class 4: Ponies - 12.2 hands & under**  
to be shown in hand

**Class 5: Ponies - 13.2 hands & under**  
to be shown in hand

**Class 6: Best Mare or Gelding not exceeding 14.2 hands**

**Class 7: Best Registered Connemara Filly or Gelding.**

**Class 8: Best Registered Connemara Colt or Filly Foal**

**Class 9: Best Connemara Brood Mare, stunted or with foal at foot**

**Class 10: Open Miniature for Horses, Under 34", 3 Years & Under**

**Class 11: Open Miniature for Horses, Under 34", 4 Years and Upwards**

**Class 12: Shetland Pony - Best Filly, Mare or Gelding to be shown in hand**

1. This competition is open to foals registered or eligible to be registered in a World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses (WBFSH) studbook or a Department of Agriculture Food and The Marine (DAFM) approved studbook with recorded breeding.
2. **Two foals** may be selected to qualify for the final if the judges and the I.S.A. agree the standard is high enough.
3. Foals must be led at all times.
4. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have the mare's passport available for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
5. Passports & Microchips should be read by a veterinary surgeon at the final.
6. Foals qualified for final are not eligible to enter any other class at the show where the final is held.
7. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.

### **RULES AND CONDITIONS**

1. This competition is open to animals, with the breed code ID, registered in The Irish Draught Horse Studbook (or a harmonised Irish Draught Studbook) with recorded breeding.
2. **One Mare and foal** may qualify at each show
3. Exhibitors to both the qualifier & Final must have their Mares passport available for inspection prior to entry to Judging Ring. **Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.**
4. Passports & Microchips should be read by a Vet at the Final.
5. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be a qualified Irish Draught Horse Judge.
6. Animals qualified for the Final are not eligible to enter any other class at Mohill Show other than qualifying classes for other ISA finals.
7. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.

1. This competition is open to animals registered in a World Breeding Federation for Sport Horses (WBFSH) studbook or a Department of Agriculture Food and The Marine (DAFM) approved studbook with recorded breeding.
2. **Two animals** may be selected to qualify for the final if the judges and the I.S.A. agree the standard is high enough.
3. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have the animal's passport available for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. **Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.**
4. Passports & Microchips should be read by a veterinary surgeon at the final.
5. Animals qualified for final are not eligible to enter any other class at the show where the final is held.
6. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.

2. Two foals from selected shows may qualify for the final if the judges and The I.S.A. agree the standard is high enough.
3. Foals must be led at all times.
4. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have the mare's passport available for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
5. Passports & (Microchips if applicable) should be read by a Vet at the Final.
6. Foals qualified for the Final are not eligible to enter any other class at the Show where the Final is held.
7. The Qualifying Exhibitor must fill out their own Qualifying Card at each Qualifying Show.
